- Overall we love the previous version and style. It does not have to fully be "Disney" again, but that direction is great. If possible more detail? or texture? (not sure of the words) would be cool - when we talked about it - it's almost the difference between moms hair vs dads in the old one - there just seems to be more depth ? or shadow- you probably know what I'm getting at. I went hunting through your work and saw these with more detail in the same direction. <https://www.artstation.com/artwork/gJ4LXm>

The background creates a setting in a mountain hike with mature trees/rocks view. This could be helpful to add details like a walking stick for the 6 year old (he's always finding one). Dogs having a harness. Dad wearing a backpack? I assume mom can still be hip carrying the baby unless you think a baby hiking carrier would look better? or a front facing baby carrier? I am not certain what would look best. hiking shoes/boots -

Having the black/white dog sit again in a similar stance is great. The white/brown dog can be up on all 4s to create variety.

I included a fall ish color pallet only to help with the idea of a fall photoshoot, but you do not need to use these exact ones.
